Phase 2 Regulations Effective July 1

Long-Term Postclosure Maintenance and Corrective Action Cost Estimates and Financial Assurance Demonstrations for Landfills (Phase 2) regulations were approved by the Office of Administrative Law on April 9, 2010. The regulations become effective on July 1, 2010. Final rulemaking documents will be available shortly on CalRecycle's Rulemaking Archives Web page.

A new Phase 2 regulation implementation Web page is under construction. The new page will include information on the development of guidance documents, a suite of planned training opportunities, and other implementation tools.
